Practices will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:40pm to 5:15pm.

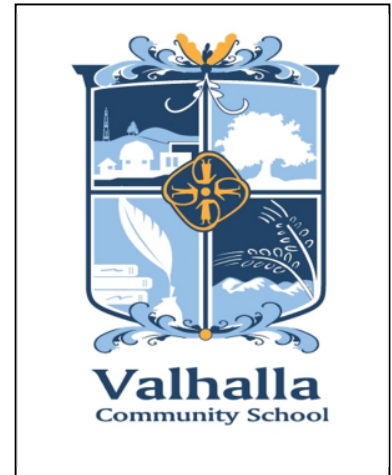
Games will hopefully be scheduled on Thursdays and there is the possibility of tournaments in February. See attached calendar.
