School supplies: We do ask that each student bring: a non-marking pair of running shoes for inside use, a back pack, a lunch kit. Please put your child's name on all their belongings.

Resource Fee: As a Public Charter School we do not charge tuition fees. Like other public schools, we do charge a fee for materials provided for the student's personal use. The fees charged are on a cost shared basis between the parent/guardian and the Valhalla Community School. Fees are as follows; Resource fee for Kindergarten \$75.00 per year, Grades 1 to 9 \$100 per year and textbook rental for grades 1 to 9 \$50.00 per year. A family total maximum is \$300 per family per year. Fees may be paid in installments or in cases of financial hardship a waiver may be made. Please contact the office for more information.

Valhalla School Council: The Annual General meeting for the Valhalla School Council will be held on September 21 beginning at 7pm in the gym. A few reminders:

If your child(ren) are going to be away from school, please inform the office and the bus driver.

If your child is going home with a friend or to a neighbor, please send a note to the bus driver and to the school.

If your child is arriving late, or being picked up early, please sign them in or out at the office.

If your child needs utensils for their lunch please provide them.

Students are **not to have** any **recording devices** at school or on school buses. Cell phones, cameras, video, speech recording, etc is not permitted as it may be a violation of the FOIP Act. The School Board has policy that forbids the use of a cell phone and electronic devices during school hours. If you feel your child needs a cell phone, the phone should remain in the student backpack. The school accepts **no responsibility** should the student misplace or lose their cell phone.

Student Agenda, message for all students K to 8: Parents are asked to initial the student agenda **each evening**, and in return, teachers will make every effort to do so each day. The agenda is an excellent way for the **home and school to communicate**. Notes regarding absence, bus travel, parent pick-up may also go in the agenda; let your child know to share your message with the teacher and office if need be.
