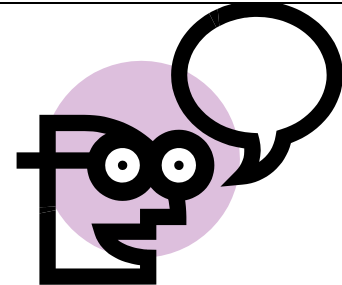
## Basketball News

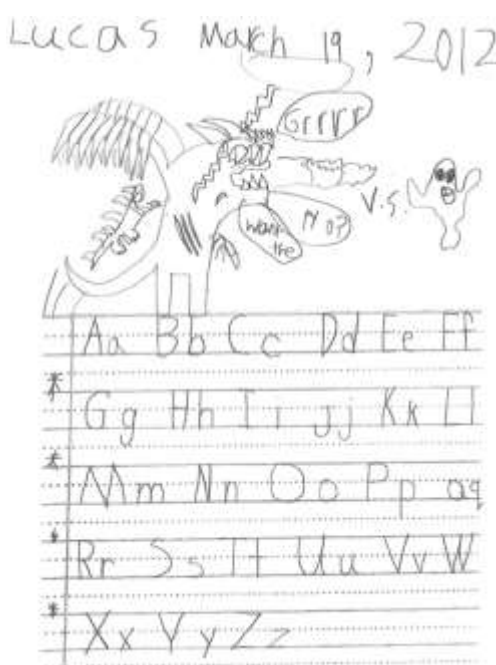
