A reminder for parents, if you are wondering whether the buses are cancelled due to winter weather issues, you can check the school website, www.valhallaschool.ca or listen for announcements on either CJXX-93.1 or Sun FM-97.7 Fm radio stations. All effort is made to have any bus cancellation announcements ready for 7:00am.

Bus drivers have reported incidents of near accidents due to students crossing to and from vehicles parked along the fence south of the school. In addition, at times the congestion of parked and departing vehicles can make it difficult for the buses to pull out safely. As a result, we are asking that people use the visitor parking on the west side of the school towards the gym and avoid parking along the fence south of the school between the hours of 8-9 a.m. and 3-4 p.m.
