- The first round of Internal Standardized Assessment (ISA) tests have been administered.
- The May 2018 Accountability Pillar Results for 3-Year Education Plans show significant improvement for VCS. This will become part of the Annual Education Results Report (AERR) published in the fall.
- More planning for the student recruitment campaign.
- The policy regarding school bus drop-offs of Grade 1-3 students was reviewed and there was agreement to revise the parent handbook to ensure adequate supervision for the student at home or an alternate drop-off.
