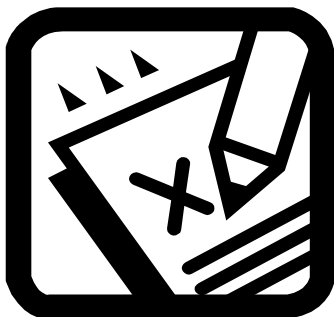
Serving on the board is a meaningful way to help our school and community.

The Annual General Meeting of the Valhalla School Foundation will be held on Monday, March 26, 2012 @ 7pm in the Viking Room of the Valhalla Viking Centre. This year two of our directors are coming to the end of their terms. Trone Arnet and Andre Harpe have both been involved with the Charter since its inception. Trone will let his name stand for another term. Andre also intends to run for re-election. In any event, interested individuals are able to let their names stand for election as a charter board director. According to our bylaws, a director must be 18 years of age or older, a parent or guardian of a child attending the VCS or a community member who is supportive of the mission of the VCS. Staff currently employed by the VCS may not be a director. Directors are elected for three year terms. An information package for potential nominees can be picked up at the office. Part of this package is The VSF Director Nomination Profile Agreement, which needs to be signed by anyone who is entering his or her name as a nominee for the director position and then returned to the school office by March 15 at 4 p.m. The names of the nominees will then be announced to our membership via the school newsletter and the school website. Please pass this information on to others who may want to consider the role of director.

The hot lunch form that was sent home for March 8 (no school that day due to teachers' convention), will be used for March 15.

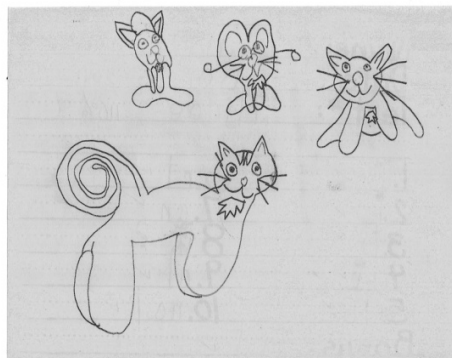
Proposed upcoming hot lunches are:
