Senior presentations: Terri (1st)

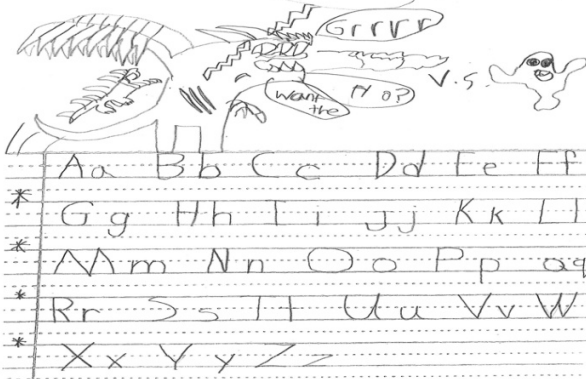
