

Valhalla Community School Fees 2020-2021

As a Public Charter School, Valhalla Community School does not charge tuition fees. Like other public schools, we do charge a Resource fee for materials provided for the student's personal use or consumption of basic instructional resources used by students which may include, but not limited to: workbooks, photocopying, technology consumables, agendas, paper, Art consumables and other general consumables. The fees charged are on a cost-shared basis between the parent/guardian and Valhalla Community School. Registration is not complete until resource fees are paid in full.

The Valhalla School Foundation Board has approved the following Resource fee structure:

Kindergarten	\$75.00
Grade 1 to Grade 9	\$150.00
Family Maximum	\$400.00

Transportation Fees

The Valhalla Community School does not charge a Transportation Fee.

Textbook Replacement Fee (Grades 1 - 9)

Textbooks will be signed out to students, and if a textbook is lost or damaged so that it is unusable, a replacement fee will be charged as follows:

New book	Full replacement cost
1 year old book	80% of replacement cost
2 year old book	50% of replacement cost

Junior High Option Fees

Grade 7-9 Students	\$50 per year

All students grade 7 to 9 will participate in option class. This fee is to cover the cost occurred by all option classes each year.

Additional Fees

Throughout the year, fees may be charged to cover the cost of participating in swimming lessons, special events, sports or special projects.
